It was rotten golfing weather once again last month, but we now have the Captains' Drive-in to look forward to on 29 March.

News and Updates from the Club Management

The Course

There has been no let-up in the continuous months of above average rainfall. The first glimmer of a change in weather patterns is due to start around 5 March, which could herald the start of drier conditions. We will be looking for a return to trolleys as soon as we are able. The petrol buggies may take a little longer but some will arrive from the depot, serviced and ready to go, on 4 March so that we are ready to get them out as soon as the soil dries out and it is safe to do so.

We were going to stop the 'carry bag stamp scheme' on 1 March but will continue it until the day that we can get the trolleys back on. The guest rounds are valid until 1 October 2020.

The green keepers have fed the greens with nitrogen, potassium and magnesium throughout the winter. They have built a new set of steps to the 10th tee. We give thanks to the Men's Committee for a 'Captain's Project' this year of laying irrigation to the 2nd, 8th and 15th tees. The lads have already started this work which will continue this month.

The two large water storage tanks will be built in March/April. The 8th and 15th tees will also be reworked in this time period.

Roadworks

Please note that there will be roadworks between Wing and the Cublington bridge on 3, 4 and 5 March so it will be best to approach the Club from the Stewkley direction. We will update the notes on the BRS tee booking system if there are any alterations to these dates.

Clubhouse News

More thanks to Brendan Langan who updated our emergency lighting in the Clubhouse after he had fitted new LED lights to the restaurant. The painting is now finished in the restaurant, but watch out for 'wet paint' signs next in corridors and changing rooms.

Sunday Roasts will be available on Sunday 15 March - see the Club noticeboard in the bar.

Rules of Golf

<u>One Ball Rule</u>. The One Ball Rule (MLR G-4) is intended for professional or elite amateur events. Its intended purpose is to stop players using balls with different laying characteristics. With no such Local Rule in place, you can borrow balls from anyone on the course.

Tip of the Month from your Club Professional, Terry Bunyan

A very simple straightforward tip this month, but a very effective one.

When just off the green, instead of chipping, if there is no hazard in your way take out your rescue/hybrid club or 5 wood and use it like a putter. Try to stand taller and closer to the ball and allow the shaft to stand more upright. The ball will come off the face a little faster.

This is very effective if you have a poor lie or need go through sticky ground. Give it a go.


