# News and Updates from the Club Management

# The Course

Rainfall totals over the last couple of months have certainly set a challenge to the greenkeepers but so far, so good. A couple of greens did show signs of disease early in the month, but regular feeding and spiking has kept this at bay. The whole course has now been slit and the leaf collector has been out several times.

We have hired an Air 2 G (air to ground) machine that blasts jets of compressed air to fragment the soil structure. This has been used across all the greens and other areas of tees, surrounds or fairways where compaction looked to be a problem. On the greens you can see ripples of green's grass radiating out away from the machine as it fires! It seems to be working well as the greens have coped with several deluges recently. The first week of December is forecast to be cold, but dry, and if this is the case we will verti-drain the greens and tees and apply their winter feed. In January we will start our winter tree maintenance program.

This winter we are noticing that fewer divots and pitch marks are being repaired. This is a request for all members to assist, as repair is vital when softer ground leads to deeper divots and pitch marks.

We require normal shoes in the bar over winter to protect carpets, so please resume changing shoes in the changing rooms once again.

## Shop News

We have fast twist, single metal spikes in the shop. We recommend that all golfers switch away from soft spikes in winter as they fill with ice, frost or mud and then golfers can slip and fall. Please take extra care on slopes and tees.

Our Christmas sale in the shop has now started and finishes on Boxing Day. There is a display island with 10% off all the following items, along with the additional 10% that members get when using their white cards:

- Single metal spikes, FJ rain gloves, umbrellas, mittens, bobble hats, snoods, golf towels, Velo SL650 carry bags, waterproof jackets and trousers (men's and ladies), waterproof hats.
- There are fresh stocks of warm winter clothing in the shop. We also sell Christmas one, three or five round vouchers if you need a gift for a golfing friend or relative.

## 2023 Rules of Golf



<u>2023 Rules of Golf</u>. There is good (and some less good) news regarding the updating of the Rules of Golf. The good news is that the R&A's and USGA's four-yearly review of the Rules of Golf has been completed, the updated Rules for 2023 have been published and they become effective on 1 January.

The less good news is that, unlike past years when all Golf Clubs received hundreds of free copies of the revised Rules for issue to members, this will no longer be the case. Forests have been saved from destruction, but golfers now have to access the 2023 Rules themselves via an R&A App, as shown here. The

2023 Rules should be available via the App from mid-December and will include explanatory videos.

To get you started, a couple of the changes to the current Rules are:

- Back-on-the-line relief: if taking relief from an unplayable ball or penalty area by moving back on line, when dropping the ball it may roll as much as one club-length in **any** direction without penalty;
- In stroke play, due to the introduction of the World Handicap System and scores being posted digitally, a player is no longer responsible either for showing handicap on a scorecard or adding up the scores.

There's some reading to be done!



## **Intelligent Golf – Your New Competition System**

Some of you may have already heard that we are moving our competition system from HowDidiDo (HDiD) to Intelligent Golf (IG). This change will take effect from 3 January 2023.

A more detailed communication will follow nearer the go-live date, providing you with access details to the IG website and, should you prefer, the mobile app link. Much of the core functionality is like HDiD, which should help in building familiarity.

We are also upgrading our Clubhouse touchscreen. In fact, there will be two new screens - one will be sited in each of the locker rooms, which will be the new locations for touchscreen entry (sign-in, scores etc).

Core member data has already been copied to IG (so please make sure you let us know if you amend any profile data!) and the Committees are progressing with updating the diary with some of next year's competitions. We are also getting to grips with the finer points of the display tools for the AVGC element of the website. Whilst there is plenty of functionality, it will take a little bit of time to get things looking as we wish.

Meanwhile, continue to use HDiD to book competitions. If any transfers of bookings are necessary across systems, the respective Committees will manage that. The usual rules regarding BRS tee times remain unchanged.

Our last day with HDiD is 31 December, when their service provision ceases, so there is a small service gap on 1 and 2 January. On these two days any general play rounds will have to be submitted via the England Golf app. Thereafter, we are using IG.

Understandably, there will be numerous questions. Whilst we will do our best to respond to informal enquiries, we would recommend waiting until the formal launch communication (which will be sent to your registered email address in the latter part of December). To supplement this, we will also hold support sessions in the Clubhouse to help get you connected.

We are looking forward to introducing you to this new development at our Club.

Quite simply, there are only 30 tee times available per day for those wanting to play 18 holes. It's not a matter of speeding up, although that is a good solution, it's letting through the following group if they, and possibly others, are on your tail. If there is room in front of you, let the following group fill it. Try looking back regularly to see what's happening behind you, there could be a trail of frustrated golfers.

November sees a slowdown in competitions. Weather permitting, we try to get a competitive game out on the Mondays and Wednesdays, with the focus on the Winter 8, Casual League and the Winter Eclectic.
