News and Updates from the Club Management

The Course

This is a really busy time for greenkeepers as we ready the course for the first flush of growth that comes with spring. The greens, tees, collars and approaches are all being aerated with the verti-drainer and Luke has reduced the spacing between the holes for additional aeration at this time. The tees and greens will all be fertilised and the fairways scarified. We will also be hiring in the Freddo Seeder, once again, to bury fresh grass seed just below the surface on tees, collars, approaches and high wear areas

around the greens. In around a month's time attention will shift to renovating the greens and the grass driving range bays.

Tree maintenance is nearing completion with just the 3rd, 4th and 5th holes left to finish. Lower branches will be removed to promote tree height and canopy development. We will be repairing the roof of the driving range.

We have some new tee signs under manufacture and these should arrive at the end of March. The advertising banner will be offered at a discounted rate to members at £300 + VAT per year. This includes the manufacturer's costs to make the sign but he will need each sponsor to send the artwork design to him. Artwork can include a QR code so that prospective customers can access your company's details. The hole number can be selected on a first come, first served basis.

Mens' Medal – 7am Shotgun Start – 11 March

The Mens' Medal on Saturday 11 March has a 7am shotgun start (allow time to get to your tee) and is followed by the AGM and Prize Presentation. This means it will be very busy at the Club from 6.15am and onwards. To ease the crush we will be using the lean-to to lay out vacuum flasks of fresh filter coffee, pots of tea, milk and sugar with an honesty pot based at £1 per drink, a selection of pastries and sausage rolls (cold) all at £1. These will be available before you tee off, but also as a quick take away as you transit from the 9th green to 10th tee and 18th green to 1st tee.

Captains' Drive In – 26 March

Sincere thanks to Neil, Charlotte, Keith and Charlie as they approach the end of their year. All are welcome to see Howard, Jane, Adrian and Leah drive in at 2pm and all are welcome afterwards in the upstairs lounge for a chat and nibbles!

Greens Maintenance

There has been a change in plan for greens maintenance. We have shown Monday 27 March, Tuesday 28 March and Wednesday 29 March as 9-hole only days in the handbook, but this will now change.

Luke is looking to hire in a much bigger and better machine this year (a GKB Sand Filler) that will scarify, plant seed and then sand fill all in one pass on the greens. However, this is only now available on Tuesday 14 March so there will now be disruption only on this day and not on 27, 28 and 29 March when all 18 holes will be available as normal.

On Tuesday 14 March the back nine holes will be available and bookable for play from 6.08am until 10.30am. The back nine greens will be normal as Luke will start on the front nine greens and they won't have been treated yet. The tees will only be available for members on this day. However, only nine holes will be available and you won't be able to play them twice. The front nine holes will remain closed all day. This would be a good day to make use of the SmartGolfer Network!

Buggies

We will start hiring buggies out on Wednesday 1 March. We have bought three new buggies, but still have our last four buggies off site being serviced, so we will begin the season with seven buggies available for booking in the normal way. By the end of March it will be getting dark at 7.40pm so this then brings in the option of a nine hole booking after work.

Road Closure near Wing 17 March.

A section of road between Wing and the Club entrance is scheduled to be closed on 17 March for the laying of cables. Access to and from the Club would then be from/to the Stewkley direction only on this day.

Pitchmarks

We have a plea from the greenkeepers for everyone to repair their pitch marks on the greens. We would also like to thank Dave/Barry/Brendan in advance for their offer of filling in divots on fairways with a top dressing/seed mix.

Rules of Golf

<u>Substituting a Ball</u>. Under the Rules of Golf, a ball may be substituted before the start of a new hole, without penalty. Whilst playing a hole, according to Rule 4.2c a ball may also be substituted if it is shown to be cut or cracked – but not if it is scratched, scraped or has damaged paint. However, under Rule 14.3a, if one is taking Relief under a Rule and dropping a ball, either the original ball or another ball may be used.

Handicap Secretary's Report

The switch to Intelligent Golf has generally gone smoothly, but please be aware that you no longer get email notifications of handicap alterations, which occur overnight after submission of the score which affects your handicap index. This underlines the need to always check your handicap before going out to play a round. If you are signing in for a general play or competition round, the system should automatically be updated, however if you are playing match play (or a casual round with friends), you may not be signing in. In such circumstances, please remember that it is your responsibility to check your handicap before playing.

Cashless will be introduced once we are confident that the majority of members are comfortable using the system for recording scores and normal competition functions. Ultimately, IG is different to our previous system and some of the things we have all taken for granted (email advising you of a handicap change) no longer exist.
